## *2017 Fishing Reports*

**May 24, 2017**

**Water is still cool!**

**CHAIN O'LAKES:** Walleye around bridges and current. Bluegill and crappie are good in the channels.

**LAKE MICHIGAN:** Perch closed until June 15<sup>th</sup>. Coho, SH, LT in 200' od Water.

**SHABBONA:** LM good on crankbaits.

**LAKE GENEVA:** Pre-spawn SM biting on jigs 5 ft. down in 12' of water. Crappie good on white plastics or fatheads in Williams Bay in 10-12' of water. LM spotty on night crawlers fished on a split shot rig or 4" green pumpkin Senkos. Perch on small fat head minnows fished 2 feet off bottom in 6-8' of water.

**LAKE DELAVAN:** Crappies good in 12' of water on chartreuse plastics fished on a 1/32 oz. jig. Walleye great at night trolling purple crank baits. BG's good on ice jig or wax worm. NP and LM sporadic.

**WOLF RIVER:** White bass going soon on minnows and flies.
