2018 Fishing Reports

February 15, 2018

Be careful as deep snow has impacted ice safety.

CHAIN O'LAKES: Ice fishing is very good, especially for bluegill and crappie on Channel; on Marie, walleye have been good, including one to 27"; pike are moving toward spawning areas.

SHABBONA: Nice perch and bluegill were caught recently; the ice is 7-8".

DELAVAN: Gills and crappies in the shallow weed beds. Pike are improving on tip-ups with roaches since the snow cover. Walleyes are good at low light periods on tip-ups and roaches.

STURGEON BAY: The whitefish bite is "on".

LAKE MICHIGAN: Ice conditions around Chicago lakefront vary with winds and weather, some have been getting perch inside the harbors.
